Participation in Generation of Income

Ordinary Members (fee £5)

Ordinary Members are expected to participate on a regular basis in the day-to-day operation of the Service.

In addition to this commitment it is expected that Ordinary Members will participate in fund raising activities or will in other acceptable ways contribute to the generation of the income required to provide HBS with financial stability.

The participation of the membership in the generation of income is central to the survival of the Service.

Associate Members (fee £5)

Associate Members are those who for personal reasons are unable to play an active part in the day to day operations, but still wish to be a member of the Service and receive regular updates on the development of its activities.

As both types of membership have the same fee, a member may simply transfer their status with notification to the membership co-ordinator.

Life Members (fee £50)

Life membership is available for a fee of 10x the Annual Fee.

It is intended to hold the information provided by you on a computer database. Your details will not be used for commercial purposes, nor will they be disclosed outwith the Service.

You may if you wish, decline to have the information held on a database, this will in no way affect your membership but will mean that you will not receive notification of events or other information mailed to members which will be generated via the computer database.
